Cathy, this is my testimonial:

After years of trying, unsuccessfully, to have longer hair I finally gave up and began wearing my hair in a very short afro. (I stopped using relaxers in the late 1990s). I finally let my hair grow out in 2005, but it "stopped" at its "usual" length - about to my jawline (combed out straight).

My daughter-in-law showed me your book in the fall of 2005. I was skeptical that this was yet another gimmick, but bought a copy anyway. As I read it I was very impressed with the way you explained why black/African American hair is different, what it really needs to help it grow longer, and how to take care of it.

Your methods made such good sense that I decided to give them a 9-week test (using my birthday as the checkpoint). I started using your concepts on my hair the last week of November 2005. By the end of the first week my hair was already looking and feeling healthier than it ever had. By the end of December it had grown noticeably longer. By my birthday (first week of February) my hair, combed straight, reached the base of my neck! I'm so excited about the way it looks, feels, and is growing, that I have to stop myself from checking it after every weekly washing, conditioning and flatironing to see how much longer it has grown!

I have recommended your book to several other African American ladies. I get compliments on my hair regularly, even from people who had not seen it the "old" way! I don't have any "current" photos yet, but when I do I'll send a set for your "before and after" page to add my testimony that your concepts really do work!

This is a long email, but to close I want to say thank you, Cathy, for sharing the fruits of your research on hair care with the rest of us. You go beyond telling us how to have long hair - you also teach us how to have healthy hair. My growing, bouncy hair is a testimony to all your hard work.
